

AMENITIES

During your stay at the Dreamers Writing Farm, visit our Secret Garden in the woods, experience a shower under the stars, enjoy our outdoor kitchenette, or hang out with our three little pigs, and our dwarf goats, the Brothers Grimm.

Secret Garden

Tucked in the woods down a mossy path, the Secret Garden is a quiet place for reflection, inspired by *The Secret Garden* and *The Chronicles of Narnia*. Step through the garden door and you'll find a simple lamppost lighting the way.

In the garden, there's a bench, a wide hammock, and a *Phone of the Wind*—a place to sit, reflect, and speak to those you miss. You'll also find swamp roses, hostas, and ornamental trees growing in this peaceful spot.

A short, marked path leads you from the main property to the garden. It's a quiet place, meant for stillness, thought, or whatever you might need most.

Meet the Animals

At the back of the property, you'll find our goats and mini pigs living together in a large paddock. The goats—Gus, Gunther, Griffin, Harry Potter, and Huckleberry Finn—are known as the Brothers Grimm. Our 3 little pigs, Cinnamon, Sugar, and Cocoa, go by the Spice Girls. They're friendly, hand-tamed, and love a good scratch.

You'll also likely spot one of our dogs during your stay, and you may notice a few cats as well. A nearby colony of feral cats often wanders through the property. Wildlife is common here too—keep an eye out for wild rabbits, birds, and even the occasional beaver near the creek.

The animals are part of what makes Dreamers feel a little more alive—and a little more like home. "AN

Marsh of Dreams

At the back of the property near the Dreamers Studio and animal paddock, you'll find the Marsh of Dreams—a quiet, sheltered spot surrounded by tall evergreens. In the spring, the water fills with tadpoles that grow into green frogs, and if you sit still long enough, you're likely to hear them singing. We haven't found a frog prince yet, but we're still looking. A small dock and a pair of Adirondack chairs offer a peaceful place to rest, reflect, or enjoy the view. To get there, look for the Dream Path sign—this little marsh is one of the calmest corners of the farm.

Complimentary high speed WIFI is available to all guests:

Firewood

Firewood is available for sale in the outdoor kitchen. Complimentary firestarting supplies can be found in the kitchen drawers. If you would like to have a campfire, please do a google search to check that campfires are currently allowed in Bruce County.

Temperature Control

The studio has a gas stove (the stove thermostat is on the wall) and A/C (in the kitchen window). The bunkies have A/C and heaters. The tents have heaters. Please do not overload the electricity by plugging in too many things at once.

Linens, Blankets and Towels

You have been supplied with fresh linens and blankets. The studio is also supplied with towels. Towels for bunkie and tent guests, as well as extra blankets, are available in the shared indoor bathroom beside the garage. Farmhouse guests can find these supplies in the farmhouse shared bathroom. Please feel free to bring a towel to your room, tent or bunkie if you plan to re-use it. Save the environment!

Garbage and Recycling

Please take large amounts of garbage to the outdoor kitchen and deposit it in the animal proof bins. Feel free to leave small amounts of garbage and recycling inside your room when you check out. The studio has a garbage proof container outside the door.

Indoor Washroom Facilities

Our indoor washroom facilities have been designed for your convenience, featuring a hot shower, utility sink, and modern flush toilet. With towels thoughtfully provided for your use, you can feel right at home during your stay. *The Dreamers Studio contains a private 3-piece washroom.

Parking

We have plenty of parking but sometimes it can be a little tight. Please use your best judgment, drive slow and be cautious of children playing and guests walking. DO NOT DRIVE IMPAIRED. Please don't park on the grass, except where you see the "Bookworm Parking Only" sign.

Barbecues

All bunkies, tents and the studio are equipped with charcoal bbqs. Propane bbqs are available in the outdoor kitchen for guest use and propane and charcoal are available for purchase. There are also bbq lighters available in the outdoor kitchen.

Television, XBOX and Other Gadgets

The studio has a television, streaming device, remote control and XBOX. In the bunkies, tents and the outdoor kitchen you can access the internet via WIFI. The signal is weak to the tents, as it's a line-of-site connection, but feel free to access the internet in the outdoor kitchen.

Outdoor Washroom Facilities

Indulge in the serenity of nature with our unique outdoor washroom facilities. Enjoy our spa-like open-air hot shower, where you can bask under the stars while cleansing your cares away. Our thoughtfully designed amenities also include a compost toilet with a French drain, housed in an Amish-built outhouse, ensuring ecoconscious practices. Wash your hands at the outdoor sink with running water, and rest assured that all water at our farm is potable.

Outdoor Kitchenette and Tuck Shop

Make the most of your stay with the convenience of our shared outdoor kitchenette and small self-serve tuck shop.

Located under a covered gazebo, our outdoor kitchenette includes:

- A garden sink with potable water
- Charcoal and propane BBQs
- Microwave and Keurig coffee machine
- Patio table for shared use

The following complimentary supplies are available in the outdoor kitchenette for guest use:

- BBQ utensils and cups/spoons for coffee and tea


Private, Peaceful Bedrooms in the Dreamers Farmhouse

- Check Local Fire Bans: Before lighting a fire, check online if there are any fire bans in effect in Bruce County.
- Firewood is available for sale in the outdoor kitchen.
- Payments can be made via e-transfer to kat@dreamerswriting.com or by placing cash in the box in the outdoor kitchen.
- Materials for starting a fire, including lighters, lighter fluid, and fire starting devices, are also available in the outdoor kitchen.
- Never leave a fire unattended. Ensure fires are fully extinguished before leaving the area or going to sleep.
- Only use the provided firepits for fires. Do not create new fire areas and do not have a campfire in a BBQ.
- Please be mindful of other guests and respect quiet hours from 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM.
- Always supervise children around firepits.
- Tidy up when you're done—ensure the firepit area is clean for the next guests.
